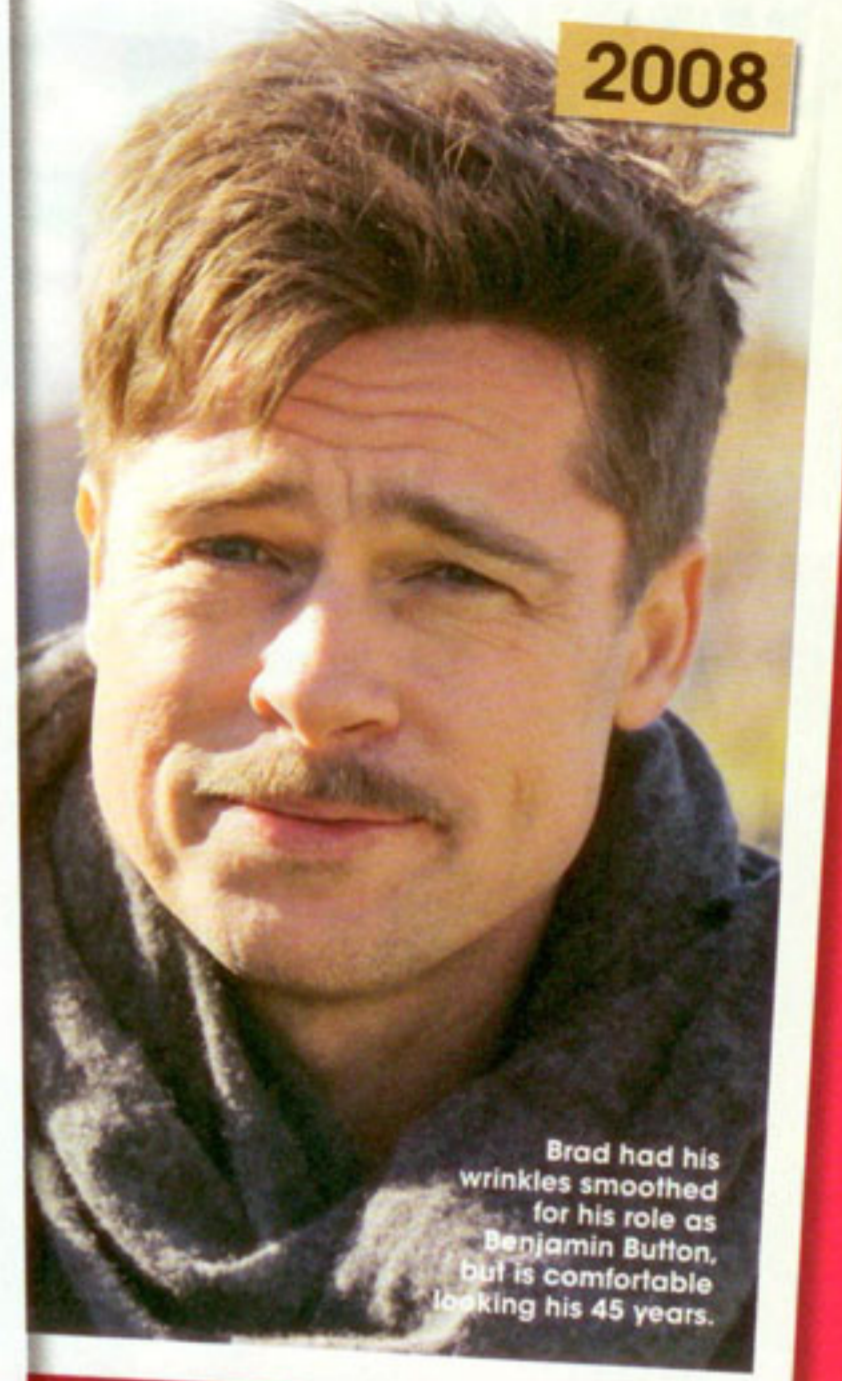

## ...BUT BRAD'S GIVEN IT UP

According to friends, it was Brad Pitt who inspired Angelina to get Botox. Insiders told *Life & Style* magazine Brad underwent the cosmetic procedure while filming *The Curious Case Of Benjamin Button*, in which he plays a man who is born old and grows younger. "She thought Brad looked great with it," says a friend. While his smooth brow in the movie may have encouraged Angelina to go the same route, Brad has clearly turned his back on the anti-wrinkle treatment. Instead, the actor's looking every bit of his 45 years as he tackles the relentless task of looking after six kids aged seven and under. "It wears you out," Brad admitted to TV interviewer Larry King. "I'm ageing fast."

**W**ITH SIX KIDS to look after, including baby twins, anyone could forgive Angelina Jolie for looking a little tired and haggard – but the 33-year-old mum has sparked whispers by looking as fresh faced as a teenager at recent red-carpet events. In October, Angelina admitted to being "exhausted" by the strain of raising a large family, and worried onlookers by appearing tired and gaunt – but just three months later she is looking wrinkle-free, relaxed and glowing. Experts say the sudden improvement in Ange's complexion is not a result of more bed rest. "She's getting Botox," an insider told *Life & Style* magazine, revealing the secret behind Angelina's smooth complexion. "She's been getting treatments every few months.

"She's a perfectionist when it comes to her looks and getting Botox has become a part of that." "Angelina has clearly had Botox injections around her eyes and forehead areas," says Sydney plastic surgeon Dr Kourosh Tavakoli, who explains the star's complexion bears all the hallmarks of the anti-wrinkle procedure. Along with regular Botox treatments, Dr Tavakoli says that it appears Angelina may also have had several other procedures, including the injection of dermal fillers. "It seems like the gaunt look on her face has been nicely corrected with the use of new-age collagen, called dermal fillers, and it appears she has had Juvéderm injected around her smile lines and in the lower

eyelid region to add volume to the face, making it look more youthful again." New York plastic surgeon Dr Andrew Jacono says Ange may also have had Juvéderm injected to eradicate the lines that run from the nose to the mouth, and a non-surgical cheek augmentation and lift. "She looks rejuvenated," he told *Life & Style* magazine. But such treatments seem to fly in the face of comments Ange made to the UK *Daily Mail's* *You* magazine in November. "I know this is going to sound corny, but I first became happy with the way I look when I became a mother," she said. "Something else comes out of you when you become a parent, as you get older, you start to see more character in your face."
