



SHARON STONE'S SHOCK NEW LOOK

The actress's radical transformation turns heads at a Hollywood dinner

Sharon Stone drew stunned stares at a star-studded dinner last week as she unveiled her startling new look.

The 51-year-old star's youthful appearance led many guests to wonder if she had gone under the knife in a bid to boost her career. Sharon seemed to be channelling **Dolly Parton** as she arrived at *An Evening with Women: Celebrating Art, Music and Equality*.

"She appears to have had changes to the shape of her eyes and cheeks," says Sydney cosmetic surgeon **Dr Kourosh Tavakoli**. "The eyes appear to have been surgically lifted and as a result she is starting to look more rounded." He says it's possible Sharon's also had collagen

filler in her lower cheeks, while her recent weight loss has served to emphasise a possible breast augmentation. "What appear to be breast implants are clearly too large for her now tiny frame and the weight loss is revealing the large gap in her cleavage area."

Fiercely defensive of her looks, the twice-married star recently settled a lawsuit against a Beverly Hills plastic surgeon who claimed he gave her a facelift in 2005. In legal documents, her lawyers wrote Sharon "has never undergone a face-lift in order to improve her physical appearance ... Stone prides herself not only on her acting ability and other talents, but also on her natural physical appearance." **WD**
